Class 6 and Class 7

Three places to be paid in each division to qualified horses only. Fastest qualifying horse will be the first place in the first division. Each division to be separated by one second.

We will not drag in these events.

Horse cannot compete against itself in the same class. Riders may ride more than one horse. Poles and barrels are organized by Overton County Horseman's Association.

Negative Coggins Test is required. Team roper can only enter twice.

RULES FOR ENTRANTS

1. Competition open to all entrants.
2. Entry fee of \$10.00 per entry (per team) in classes 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10. \$15.00 per entry in classes 6, 7.
3. No entries will be accepted after 8:00 p.m.
4. Entry fees will not be refunded for withdrawals of entrants in a class in progress.
5. Judges decisions are final in all classes.
6. Entrants names will be called only twice. A one-minute timer will begin after second call. If contestant has not entered the ring at the expiration of the timer, horse and rider will be disqualified.
7. Disqualified riders will not be eligible for a refund of their entry fee.
8. Adjustments cannot be made to any poles, barrels or other course designations without judges prior approval.
9. Non-approved adjustments will be subject to time penalties or disqualification as determined by the judge.
10. Horses may be entered in each class only once.
11. 2016 TSCA rules and guidelines will be followed when applicable, unless otherwise stated above. (Judges determination)
12. Unauthorized persons will not be allowed inside the show ring during any part of the competition.
13. American Bank & Trust, OCHA or OCFB Association will not be responsible for any accidents, injuries, or theft. You will be competing at your own risk.
